She assembles a wonderful staff devoted to their difficult and often demanding patients. After establishing a thriving practice, Clara must decide whether to leave a place where lives are saved, courage is rewarded, and humor and optimism triumph over greed and self-pity.

The Lost Quilter by *Jennifer Chiaverini*

A wonderful novel of family reaching out from the grave to touch the future. Master Quilter Sylvia Bergstrom Compson treasures a quilt in her possession because it was made by a fugitive slave the family secreted from the Underground Railroad in 1859. The slave Johanna soon lost her freedom again, but the family raised her son and all was soon forgotten. Now Sylvia feels a need to make present day connections.

Love Mercy by *Earlene Fowler*

After losing her husband, Love Mercy Johnson has settled into a busy, comfortable routine in Morro Bay, California. Involved with her in-laws ranch, she is tries to move on. But she doesn't know if she will ever reconcile with her grandchildren. When a brokenhearted granddaughter shows up on her porch, Mercy sees it as a second chance. Together the two struggle to understand and come to terms with their past.

Good Luck (Women's Fiction) by *Whitney Gaskell*

Can \$87 million buy happiness? Lucy Parker is about to find out. Life is a mess when she suddenly wins the lottery. Now Lucy heads for the Palm Beach lifestyle. But she begins to realize that the lifestyle of the rich and not so famous is not all its cracked up to be. Suddenly Lucy's old life doesn't look so bad, and just when she's about to cash it all in, life has one more surprise.

Still Alice by *Lisa Genova*

The Writing on My Forehead by *Nafisa Haji*

This is a moving meditation on the meaning of family, tradition, and the ties that bind. It's lyrical and touching. It is a story of mothers and daughters, and a story of a young Muslim woman at a crossroads, shaped by the forces of her past, her religion, her roots, her culture, and her own determined will.

True Colors by *Kristin Hannah*

With breathtaking pace and penetrating insight, True Colors is a novel about sibling rivalry, betrayal, vengeance and forgiveness. Hannah explores the deep, emotional connection between sisters. She creates a beautiful and captivating story of love and rivalry, family and community that readers will love.

Prayers, Paws and Providence: Tales from Grace Chapel Inn by *Diann Hunt*

Once you visit Acorn Hill, you'll never want to leave. It's the kind of town where friendships bloom. Two very special dogs arrive in town and Alice wonders if this could be the answer to her prayers. She knows a disabled single woman who could use a guardian angel. And a service dog might be just the right thing.

Knit Two: Sequel to Friday Night Knitting Club (Women's Lit) by *Kate Jacobs*

Five years after the death of Georgia Walker, founder of the Walker and Daughter knitting shop, her daughter, Dakota, is running the shop part time with help from members of the Friday Night Knitting Club. With all the member's challenges, the author focuses once again to the difficulties and joys of being a mother, wife, daughter, and friend. Knit Two is a tribute to the friendships of women.

A Dog Named Christmas by *Greg Kincaid*

A family takes in a very special animal, and the shelter's Christmas adoption program soon grows larger than anyone had hoped. By the story's end, Todd, with the help of a dog named Christmas, has taught the entire community the transformative power of goodwill and love. Here is a lesson for all seasons.

The Hour I First Believed: a Novel (Bestseller) by *Wally Lamb*

Enjoy this novel about the search for meaning. Caelum Quirk and his wife move to Littleton, Colorado and his wife becomes a psychological victim of the Columbine tragedy. Seeking peace and room for recovery the couple returns to Caelum's family farm in Connecticut. There Caelum uncovers disturbing family secrets. Together the couple struggles with the past to fashion a future life of peace and meaning.

Irreplaceable by *Stephen Lovely*

Alex Voorman is a bright, witty, intense, thirty-year-old archeologist. His wife, Isabel is killed in an auto accident. Isabel elected to donate her organs to another in the event of her death. Her heart is sent to Janet, a woman who would die without it. Years later the woman gets in touch with Alex. The novel revolves around what happens next and the implications it has for both Alex and Janet's family.

Promises of Change (Women's Fiction) by *Joan Medlicott*

Women over sixty-five can reinvent their lives, invite in adventure, and even love. In the peaceful hamlet of Covington the lives of family, friends and community are taking their toll. Zach and his pregnant wife have moved in with his father and Grace has a health scare, which forces her to reassess her diet plans. Lucy Banks' brother returns from Iraq with physical and emotional issues. And Miriam falls in love on a trip to New Mexico.

The World According to Bertie by *Alexander McCall-Smith*

Pat deals with the reappearance of Bruce which has her heart skipping, and not in a good way! Cyril the dog has been impounded as a serial biter. And Domenica has strangely offered to free him if she can. And then there's Bertie, the six year old prodigy who's decided to use his little brother Ulysses to outmaneuver his mother.

Handle With Care by *Jodi Picoult*

Picoult's novels center on family, love and relationships. Picoult's plots bring to light questions and issues that remain with a reader. Every expectant parent says they don't want a perfect baby, just a healthy one. Charlotte and Sean confront questions after problem arise with their healthy baby girl. What would they have done differently if they had known of Willow's illness before she was born? And what makes a valuable life?

Death with Interruptions (Nobel Prize for Literature) by *Jose Saramago*

What if Death took a holiday or fell in love and left humankind without death but with the permanently dying? There would probably be some celebrations for those spared, but what about those in limbo? This book considers the implications.

Time of My Life by *Allison Winn Scotch*

Jillian Westfield has the perfect husband, family and marriage right down to the lemon-scented house in the suburbs. And yet she finds herself wondering about the life she left behind. Sure, those days were hectic and unpredictable, but also full of possibility. She still wonders what if...and then she gets a chance to find out.

The House on Tradd Street by *Karen White*

Melanie Middleton has been left a large Victorian house complete with housekeeper, dog and ghosts! Handsome Jack Trenholm is a writer obsessed with mysteries. He's heard there are diamonds buried in the old place. So he turns on the charm, only to find

that he is the smitten one. Now he's caught the attention of a malevolent resident ghost as well. Together the two must unravel the mystery of passion, heartbreak and murder.

HISTORICAL FICTION

Paths of Glory by *Jeffrey Archer*

Paths of Glory is a fictional account of George Mallory, who once told a reporter that he wanted to climb Mt. Everest "because it's there." On his third attempt in 1924, he was last seen six hundred feet from the top. His body was found in 1999, and it still remains a mystery whether he ever reached the summit. This is a novel about a courageous man who followed his dream. He may have achieved it, but we may never know.

Hotel on the Corner of Bitter and Sweet by *Jamie Ford*

Chinese American Henry Lee is filled with poignant memories from World War II when he happens upon the opening of an old Seattle building. It's filled with the belongings of World War II Japanese Americans. When the new owner opens a Japanese parasol, the memories of that time flood back.

Grave Goods: Mistress of the Art of Death Novel by *Ariana Franklin*

A fascinating historical novel set in 12th Century Wales. The setting: Glastonbury Abbey-1176. After a recent fire at the abbey two skeletons are uncovered. Could they be the remains of King Arthur and his Queen? King Henry II calls on Adelia Aguilar, Mistress of the Art of Death to investigate. She rides to Glastonbury where the Bishop of St. Albans will oversee the investigation.

The Color of Lightning by *Paulette Jiles*

This novel examines the relations between settlers and Indians just after the Civil War. Brit Johnson, a newly freed slave, decides to move his wife and children out west in search of a future. When tragedy strikes, he vows to never give up searching for his loved ones. Samuel Hammond decides to reach out to the Indians as an Indian Agent only to find that the people he tries to help scoff and deride his efforts. A magnificent novel based on true events.

The Independence of Miss Mary Bennet by *Colleen McCullough*

Based on the story of sisters Elizabeth and Jane Bennet in *Pride and Prejudice*, Our story follows the life of Mary, who is their mother's caretaker until she passes away. Freed from her circumstances, Mary plunges from one predicament to another, finding long-buried secrets, unexpected dangers, and unlooked-for love.

Anne of Green Gables by *Lucy Maud Montgomery*

One of the most beloved novels ever written about Anne, and eleven year old orphan who is sent by mistake to live with a middle-aged brother and sister. With her

indomitable spirit, Anne wins the love of her foster family and makes an indelible impression on everyone she meets. This is a wonderful story about growing up in the maritime provinces of Canada.

The Last Secret by *Mary McCarry Morris*

This novel explores the consequences of one family's crimes of the heart. Nora Hammond has it all: family, great job, and privileged life. But it could all unravel when she discovers her husband's infidelity and her own terrifying past.

The Help by *Kathryn Stockett*

This is a story set in the Mississippi of the 1960s. Aibileen is the black maid who is raising Skeeter, a white college coed recently returned from "Ole Miss". Her mother can't wait to get her properly married off. In the meantime, Aibileen, wise and regal and her best friend Minny, who can't keep a job, continue to work on Skeeter.

Land of Marvels by *Barry Unsworth*

Barry Unsworth has the extraordinary ability to re-create the past and make it relevant to contemporary readers. In this historical thriller set in 1914, he brings to life the schemes and double-dealings of Western nations grappling for a foothold in Mesopotamia (now Iraq) in the dying days of Ottoman Empire.

The pressure increases when Haller learns that a killer is after him now. Enter Harry Bosch, who will do whatever he needs to do, including using Haller as bait. A turn of affairs forces Haller and Bosch to become allies.

Corsair: a Novel of the Oregon Files by *Clive Cussler with Jack Du Brul*

A Novel about pirates and intrigue. When the Secretary of State's plane crashes while bringing her to a summit meeting in Libya, the CIA, distrusting the Libyans, sends Juan Cabrillo to search for her. They find the plane, but the Secretary of State is missing. It turns out the Libyans have other plans and Cabrillo can't let that happen.

Medusa by *Clive Cussler with Paul Kemprecos*

Odd things are happening in the seas off Bermuda and Micronesia. Government undersea labs and vehicles are disappearing. But Kurt Austin puts the NUMA team on the case. What they find is a series of medical experiments, an extraordinarily ambitious Chinese criminal organization, and a secret new virus that threatens to set off a worldwide pandemic.

The Bodies Left Behind by *Jeffery Deaver*

Odd things happen one spring night in a small Wisconsin town. Interrupted phone calls and off-duty deputy Brynn McKenzie investigates. Dead bodies turn up, but before Brynn can call for backup she nearly becomes a victim herself. Brynn flees on foot with a friend of the murder victims while being chased. These two are going to have to pool their resources if they intend to stay alive. Full of suspense and typical Deaver.

The Gatehouse by *Nelson DeMille*

Upon returning to Long Island Sound from a world yachting tour, John Sutter is faced with problems he thought he'd left behind. With his Mafia connections severed and his ex-wife gone, he thought he had it made. But his wife is back and her last victims' son now wants revenge. Oh, yes, and certain people want John back in the "family". Now Sutter finds himself being pulled into a deeper web of seduction and intrigue.

Extreme Measures by *Vince Flynn*

Al-Qaeda is on the loose after the CIA intercepted two cells. Operative Mitch Rapp will need the best there is. And that means Marine Corps officer Mike Nash. Both men have done things and been people most Americans wouldn't understand. Now the political winds in Washington have changed, and many are calling for men like Rapp and Nash to be put on a short leash. Then, one spring afternoon, everything changes.

Black Ops by *W.E.B. Griffin*

Early reports reached Delta Force Lt. Col. Castillo via back-channel messages about the deaths of covert intelligence assets. Castillo finds the information infuriating and, at the same time, fascinating. Castillo believes it's a matter of time before he's assigned the case. The Doctor Digs a Grave by *Robin Hathaway*

Dr. Andrew Fenimore is a well respected cardiologist by day and a sleuth off duty. A local lad needs help finding a final resting place for his pet cat, but to his and the Dr's surprise they unearth a young woman buried according to an ancient Indian tradition. Dr. Fenimore's knowledge of blood chemistry and herbal properties will be a key in solving the mystery.

A Darker Place by *Jack Higgins*

Russian writer and ex-paratrooper Alexander Kurbsky is trying to get out of Russia. He's determined to get away from a government that could take him out at any time. Kurbsky's seen too many of his compatriots disappear mysteriously at the hands of Russian agents. Now he's making plans with Charles Ferguson and Sean Dillon and the rest of the "gang" to go under cover. But is Kurbsky a double agent?

Blood Sins by *Kay Hooper*

FBI Special Crimes Unit Investigator Noah Bishop enlists the aid of psychic Tessa Gray to flush out a charismatic "reverend".
