In the search that follows, the line between friend and foe becomes increasingly impossible to define or defend.

Tsar by *Ted Bell*

Russia is at the world's throat again. One of the most powerful men in the world is pulling strings and pulling them hard! And Russia is more formidable than it was during the cold war. With an eye on Europe's oil supply and America's markets, uncertainty lie ahead. And this time counter-terror agent Alex Hawke faces a global nightmare.

Nemesis: the Final Case of Eliot Ness by *William Bernhardt*

Famous detective Eliot Ness has achieved a national reputation for taking down the notorious Al Capone. Ever since, his job has largely been about public relations. There have been a few odd cases here and there. But now "The Torso Murderer" has been active in Cleveland, and the locals are clamoring for a champion. Ness doesn't feel he has the authority to solve the case, but now it's become his obsession.

Charlemagne Pursuit by *Steve Berry*

Former Justice Department agent Cotton Malone is on a hunt for the truth. He wants to know what really happened to his father who died in a submarine disaster in the North Atlantic. Dorothea Lindauer and Christl, twin sisters, are fighting for the fortune promised to the person who discovers what happened to their father. Both will become enmeshed in this mystery before our story ends. Earlier exploration of Antarctica by the Nazis caused many deaths. And an American Admiral is trying to hush it all up.

Three Weeks to Say Goodbye by *C. J. Box*

Jack and Melissa McGuane spent years trying to have a baby of their own. In the end their dream came true with the adoption of their daughter Angelina. But nine months later, Angelina's birth father shows up after being pressured by his father the judge to own up to his responsibilities. When the McGuanes sit down with the judge and his son they soon discover a hidden agenda. And that agenda doesn't include Angelina.

Dark of Night by *Suzanne Brockman*

Led by former Navy SEAL Lawrence Decker, a mismatched team of investigators band together to uncover the truth and bring the killers to justice. But the stakes are raised higher when Decker barely survives an assassination attempt. Now it's clear: the hunters have become the hunted-the elite SEALS are now fighting for their lives.

Just Take My Heart by *Mary Higgins Clark*

In her new thriller, America's #1 bestselling Queen of Suspense delves into a legal battle over the guilt or innocence of a man accused of murdering his wife. Woven into the plot is

a little-understood, eerie but documented medical phenomenon: the emergence of a donor's traits and memories in the recipient of a heart transplant.

Long Lost by *Harlan Coben*

Now, alone with a child and broken marriage, Terese receives a call from Paris that her ex has been found dead and the police suspect her. When more revelations about Terese's past come up, Myron is left with few options.

The Brass Verdict by *Michael Connelly*

This is Connelly's most explosive novel to date. After the murder of his former colleague, Haller inherits the biggest case he's ever had defending a prominent Hollywood producer and his wife. The pressure increases when Haller learns that a killer is after him now. Enter Harry Bosch, who will do whatever he needs to do, including using Haller as bait. A turn of affairs forces Haller and Bosch to become allies.

Corsair: a Novel of the Oregon Files by *Clive Cussler with Jack Du Brul*

A Novel about pirates and intrigue. When the Secretary of State's plane crashes while bringing her to a summit meeting in Libya, the CIA, distrusting the Libyans, sends Juan Cabrillo to search for her. They find the plane, but the Secretary of State is missing. It turns out the Libyans have other plans and Cabrillo can't let that happen.

Medusa by *Clive Cussler with Paul Kemprecos*

Odd things are happening in the seas off Bermuda and Micronesia. Government undersea labs and vehicles are disappearing. But Kurt Austin puts the NUMA team on the case. What they find is a series of medical experiments, an extraordinarily ambitious Chinese criminal organization, and a secret new virus that threatens to set off a worldwide pandemic.

The Bodies Left Behind by *Jeffery Deaver*

Odd things happen one spring night in a small Wisconsin town. Interrupted phone calls and off-duty deputy Brynn McKenzie investigates. Dead bodies turn up, but before Brynn can call for backup she nearly becomes a victim herself. Brynn flees on foot with a friend of the murder victims while being chased. These two are going to have to pool their resources if they intend to stay alive. Full of suspense and typical Deaver.

The Gatehouse by *Nelson DeMille*

Upon returning to Long Island Sound from a world yachting tour, John Sutter is faced with problems he thought he'd left behind. With his Mafia connections severed and his ex-wife gone, he thought he had it made. But his wife is back and her last victims' son now wants revenge. Oh, yes, and certain people want John back in the "family". Now Sutter finds himself being pulled into a deeper web of seduction and intrigue.

Extreme Measures by *Vince Flynn*

Al-Qaeda is on the loose after the CIA intercepted two cells. Operative Mitch Rapp will need the best there is. And that means Marine Corps officer Mike Nash. Both men have

done things and been people most Americans wouldn't understand. Now the political winds in Washington have changed, and many are calling for men like Rapp and Nash to be put on a short leash. Then, one spring afternoon, everything changes.

Black Ops by *W.E.B. Griffin*

Early reports reached Delta Force Lt. Col. Castillo via back-channel messages about the deaths of covert intelligence assets. Castillo finds the information infuriating and, at the same time, fascinating. Castillo believes it's a matter of time before he's assigned the case. In the meantime, he'll let the other intelligence agencies fight among themselves.

Above the Law by *Tim Green*

Attorney Casey Jordan has closed her high-powered practice and opened a legal aid clinic. When an illegal Mexican immigrant is found shot to death on a ranch outside Dallas, it makes the news, not because the victim was Mexican, but because the shooter is Senator Tucker Dean. The Senator spins a tearful tale at the press conference, but the Mexican's wife tells a different story.

Born to Run by *James Grippando*

Jack Swyteck and his father Harry are close now, after years of estrangement. Harry had been governor for several terms and so was not surprised at the invitation to run for VP on the national ticket. Naturally, he turned to his son when he needed a good lawyer. But things suddenly look dangerous for Jack when he gets caught up in an international cover-up from 50 years earlier. Before hostages can be released, embarrassing secrets have to be revealed that could threaten the President.

Intent to Kill by *James Grippando*

In this gripping thriller a fallen baseball star must use his new skills as Boston's king of sports talk radio to outwit a dangerous caller and prove, live and on the air, that the hit and run accident that killed his wife was calculated

The Associate by *John Grisham*

Kyle McAvoy is a rich, smart young man who grew up in his father's law office. Highly intelligent and voted "Most Likely to Succeed", Kyle keeps a dark secret from his past. His secret falls into the wrong hands and Kyle is forced to take a job he really doesn't want at the largest law firm in the world. In addition to practicing law, he's expected to lie, steal and take part in unsavory schemes. Typical Grisham.

Don't Look Twice by *Andrew Gross*

Don't Look Twice offers the perfect blend of menace of normality. Andrew Gross is a master of no-nonsense, good, old fashioned suspense. Psychologically intuitive, paced with throat-clutching suspense, and littered with surprises from start to finish.

The Doctor Digs a Grave by *Robin Hathaway*

Dr. Andrew Fenimore is a well respected cardiologist by day and a sleuth off duty. A local lad needs help finding a final resting place for his pet cat, but to his and the Dr's surprise they unearth a young woman buried according to an ancient Indian tradition. Dr.

Fenimore's knowledge of blood chemistry and herbal properties will be a key in solving the mystery.

A Darker Place by *Jack Higgins*

Russian writer and ex-paratrooper Alexander Kurbsky is trying to get out of Russia. He's determined to get away from a government that could take him out at any time. Kurbsky's seen too many of his compatriots disappear mysteriously at the hands of Russian agents. Now he's making plans with Charles Furguson and Sean Dillon and the rest of the "gang" to go under cover. But is Kurbsky a double agent?

Blood Sins by *Kay Hooper*

FBI Special Crimes Unit Investigator Noah Bishop enlists the aid of psychic Tessa Gray to flush out a charismatic "reverend". Two women turned up murdered in the cult compound recently, and Bishop is desperate to nab the charismatic churchman. This confrontation will be the ultimate test of wills between Tessa and the madman. But at least Bishop's on her side.

Wicked Game by *Lisa Jackson and Nancy Bush*

This novel is reminiscent of the classic *And Then There Were None*. Wild child Jessie Brentwood vanished from St Elizabeth's high school 20 years ago. No one knew what had happened. Recently a body has been found on the school grounds. Jessie's former school mates have returned for the occasion, but now they too seem to be disappearing, one by one.

The Sign by *Raymond Khoury* (Historical)

It begins as a phenomenon in Antarctica. While making a news film for CNN, a bright, shimmering sphere of light suddenly appears in the sky, enveloping the reporter's ship in a luminous light. Meanwhile, in Egypt, a group of men are discussing world affairs when the same sphere appears to the group. This soon becomes a world event. Is this a sign of the End Times or something more sinister?

Road Dogs by *Elmore Leonard*

Three of Leonard's regular characters are featured in this new novel. Fresh out of prison, Foley hooks up with Dawn Navarro, the common-law wife of Foley's wealthy friend, Cundo Rey, in a plan to relieve Cundo of his fortune. Can money trump friendship?

Fugitive by *Phillip Margolin*

Criminal lawyer Amanda Jaffe returns and this time she has her hands full. Petty con-man Charlie Marsh has fled to Africa to avoid prosecution in Oregon for the death of a congressman. Now he's being chased out of Africa for philandering with the wrong person. Jaffe's job is to keep Charlie alive long enough to find out some answers.

Final Justice by *Fern Michaels*

The Sisterhood is hoping to get that Presidential pardon for past indiscretions, but media mogul Ruben Ransom has thrown his considerable resources behind an opposing

candidate. If they're going to derail this effort by Ransom, the Sisterhood will have to use every ruse in their arsenal. And they have a plan.

Show No Fear by *Perri O'Shaughnessy*

Nina Reilly has her hands full. As a paralegal single mom fighting for the custody of her son while overseeing her mother's medical lawsuit, all she needs is another distraction! But, when a woman falls off a nearby bridge and witnesses disappear, this doesn't look like a normal "accident". So Nina and homicide cop Paul van Wagoner investigate.

Final Breath by *Kevin O'Brien*

Sydney Jordan is nervous. And she should be. Several random deaths across the country turn up and with each one Sydney receives a sign in the form of a macabre souvenir. A Portland couple is murdered. A Chicago woman plummets to her death. An aspiring screenwriter is smothered in his New York apartment. Sydney better keep her eyes out or she could be next!

Bone By Bone by *Carol O'Connell*

In a Northern California town two brothers go into the woods one day, but only one comes back. What happened to Josh? No one knows. His brother, Oren, returns home after a long career as an Army CID Investigator. His first night back and each night thereafter finds his brother's bones turning up on his porch, one by one. Using his skills from the Army, Oren investigates.

The Second Opinion by *Michael Palmer*

Dr. Thea Sperelakis chose to work for Doctors Without Borders in Africa. Her father, Petros is the founder and leader of a famous clinic in Boston. When Thea hears her father is involved in a near-fatal car accident, she leaves Africa. Upon returning to Boston, Thea and her brother Dimitri find that their siblings are demanding that treatment be withheld from their father. As Thea investigates, things look fishy.

The Renegades by *T. Jefferson Parker*

Some say the outlaws of the Old West are gone forever. But Charlie Hood knows that nothing could be further from the truth. In the new Frontier, Charlie prefers to ride alone at night where he sees the same dangers. When Charlie's partner is killed, he finds out that the nickname, "Mr. Wonderful", didn't always apply. As Charlie sets out to find the gunman, he knows one thing: the Wild West is still alive.

Eclipse by *Richard North Patterson*

Attorney Damon Pierce's life is coming unglued. With his life coming apart, he receives a plea for help from a former lover, Marissa Okari. Marissa's husband Bobby is the leader of an African nation in turmoil. And now Bobbi is in jail in need of a competent attorney. Damon Pierce takes up the challenge, but, to his surprise, finds a dangerous situation. There's a show trial and a dangerous race against time.

Runner by *Thomas Perry*

For ten years Native American guide Jane Whitefield pursued her career, moving people from being hunted to normal civilian. Now she's promised her husband to bury the past and settle into domestic bliss. At a hospital fundraiser, a bomb goes off creating mayhem. Now she has one more client she needs to turn from victim to runner.

Look Again by *Lisa Scottaline*

When Ellen Gleeson gets a Lost Child notice in the mail, she notices a striking similarity between the picture on the flyer and her adopted son. How could this be? She adopted him legally. Now she feels compelled to investigate. If her son rightfully belongs to someone else, should she keep him or give him up? As Ellen digs deeper, she risks her life and that of her son.

Bloodprint by *Kitty Sewell*

From Key West to the Georgian town of Bath, runs the thread of this suspenseful novel. As she's coming to terms with her own past, psychoanalyst Madeleine Frank is thrown off balance by the arrival of a new patient whose past seems familiar. Their increasing familiarity will unleash a terrifying series of events which neither could have predicted.

Testimony by *Anita Shreve*

At a prestigious New England boarding school a sex scandal is about to break. What is worse is that the whole thing was caught on tape. Now the Pandora's box of revelations trigger unforeseen consequences for all involved. A novel about the unforeseen outcomes of seemingly unimportant actions.

Breakneck by *Erica Spindler*

Mary Riggio and Kitt Lundgren, detectives in the Violent Crimes Bureau in Rockford, Illinois, are faced with a series of college student murders. The case goes cold until more victims turn up, one after another. With the number of victims increasing, M.C. and Kitt are left with little to follow. Soon the inability to solve the cases begins to take a toll on M.C.'s personal life and puts the detective's friendship in jeopardy.

The Tourist by *Olen Steinhauer*

Olen Steinhauer tells a contemporary story of betrayal, loyalty and risk. His first-class spy novels have ranked at the top of Booklist's and the New York Times's best sellers. Burnt-out CIA agent Milo Weaver is forced into the field one last time. But now he's got a family, a mortgage, and is comfortably settled. An assassin's arrest implicates a former colleague with implications for some of Steinhauer's former work.

The Night Stalker by James Swain

Abb Grimes killed eighteen women, so he's pretty famous in Broward county. Jack Carpenter is intimately familiar with the case as a member of the county Missing Persons Unit. Just days away from execution for his grizzly crimes, Abb makes an odd request of Jack: Abb's grandson has been lured from his home. The cops think Abb is behind it all, but Jack's not so sure so he takes the case.

Mounting Fears by *Stuart Woods*

President Will Lee is having a rough week. His vice president just died in surgery and the confirmation hearing for a successor is not going well. The rogue CIA agent Teddy Fay is still shadowing the president's wife and plotting his revenge. On top of this the world is looking at loose nukes in Pakistan that could precipitate WWIII. Now, it's up to President Lee and his friends to save the world and the upcoming election.

Dead Silence by *Randy Wayne White*

Doc Ford and former British agent Sir James Monbard are assigned to pick up the new U.S. Senator with whom Ford has become friendly, when an abduction attempt takes place. The Senator is saved, but her companion, a teenage boy who won a lottery is abducted. The kidnappers are demanding secret U.S. intelligence about Cuba. And to make sure the child won't be found, they've buried him alive. Will Ford make it in time?

Collision by *Jeff Abbott*

This is the story of two completely different men, living very different lives, thrown together unexpectedly. One is a corporate consultant still mourning the death of his recent bride, and the other is a former CIA agent known only as "Pilgrim", working for a fringe espionage agency. With everything at stake and no one to trust, these two are forced to rely on each other to survive.

Divine Justice by *David Baldacci*

Stone has silenced two of his adversaries, but now the government is on the hunt for him. And his worst nemesis, Macklyn Hayes is still out to get him. At least Stone has the *Camel Club* on his side and they are doing everything possible to save their leader.

Takeover by *Lisa Black*

Forensic scientist Theresa Maclean is on a separate case when she learns that her police detective husband and six other agents have been taken hostage in the Federal Reserve Bank. A high profile negotiator has been brought in by the police, but Maclean doubts his abilities will work this time around. As the situation escalates and eventually involves Maclean herself, she starts to wonder if all the self sacrifice is worth it.

Blood Trail by *C.J. Box*

A hunter is found strung up and dressed like the game he was chasing. Ripples of horror spread through the community and the governor ends hunting season early for the first time in the states history. Is the killer a deranged anti-hunting activist? Is he a lone killer with a personal vendetta? With more clues turning up, Warden Picket is called upon to solve the crime.

Playing Dead by *Allison Brennan*

Ex-cop Tom O'Brien is running from the law, convicted of crimes he didn't commit. Escaped from prison, he's determined to prove his innocence. But first he must convince his own daughter who testified against him. O'Brien has evidence he was framed, but as the FBI befriends his daughter, he sees his chances slipping away.

Shadow Command by *Dale Brown*

Patrick McLanahan is determined to secure America's honor around the world and his belief in a space-based military defense. When the Russians threaten and the American President fails to answer, America's most advanced military unit rebels against the very government it's charged to protect. In a race against time, McLanahan must outmaneuver his own countrymen, defeat the Russians, and expose the truth.

Foreign Body by *Robin Cook*

Jennifer Hernandez is a medical student who follows the news surrounding medical tourism: first world citizens who have medical procedures performed in the third world. Her attention is riveted when word comes of her grandmother's death while undergoing hip surgery in India. Jennifer travels to India to investigate, so she calls on the assistance of medical examiner Dr. Laurie Montgomery.

The Assassin by *Stephen Coonts*

Al-Qaeda leader Abu Qasim, who was imprisoned by the Americans has escaped and government and western business leaders are hot on his heels. When a Russian dissident is found poisoned in London, it becomes clear that Qasim has turned the table on his foes. The Navy dispatches special agent Tommy Carmellini to infiltrate the plot.

Scarpetta by *Patricia Cornwell*

Travelling from her home in Charleston, South Carolina to NYC, forensic pathologist Kay Scarpetta has accepted an assignment from the NYPD to examine a curious injured man in a psychiatric ward. The man tells Scarpetta that his injuries were inflicted during a crime he didn't commit. Now Scarpetta wonders if he's lying or is actually a victim.

The Broken Window by *Jeffrey Deaver*

A psychotic killer with access to the country's biggest data mine is using detailed information he extracts to rape, rob and kill, then blames unsuspecting innocents for the crimes. His knowledge of the victims and his ability to plant damning evidence assure that even vocal protests of innocence go ignored by the police and juries. The killer has seemingly mastered the perfect murder until he picks the wrong person.

Silks by *Dick Francis and Felix Francis*

Defense Lawyer Geoffrey Mason's life is in utter turmoil. A client he's not fond of just got off with a light sentence, and now, just as he gets back to his true passion of steeple chasing, a fellow rider turns up dead. The prime suspect is Steve Mitchell, local racing champion. Mason's refusal to take on his defense leads him into a web of intrigue and violence.

The Likeness by *Tana French*

Detective Cassie Maddox returns trying to recover from her previous case. She transferred out of the murder squad and now works with Detective Sam O'Neill. Out of the blue he asks her to join him on a new case: Outside of Dublin a young woman is found stabbed to death but she looks like Cassie and sports Cassie's old undercover ID.

Say Goodbye by *Lisa Gardner*

As a member of the Evidence Recovery Team, dead hookers aren't exactly FBI Agent Kimberly Quincy's specialty. Being 5 months pregnant, she has other things to worry about besides a lunatic who used spiders to do his dirty work. Now Kimberly is caught in a lethal web and the more she fights for answers, the more tightly she's trapped. Perhaps she's just too close to a certain psychopath.

The Keepsake by *Tess Gerritsen*

For years a perfectly preserved mummy lay forgotten in the basement of Boston's Crispin Museum. Appearing to be of ancient origin, locals had dubbed her "Madam X". But medical examiner Maura Isles makes a macabre discovery revealing the recent origin of the "mummy". Upon further investigation, Maura and homicide detective Jane Rizzoli discover more "mummies" Now Maura must summon her own dusty knowledge of ancient death traditions to unravel the murderer's twisted end game.

Rough Justice by *Jack Higgins*

The President's trusted agent Blake Johnson and his counterpart in Britain are dispatched to report on the situation in troubled Kosovo. Together, they work together to stop a Russian officer from igniting an international incident by torching a local mosque. Killing the Russian only sets off a spiraling series of events that reach top levels of governments around the world. Death begets death and revenge returns revenge.

Left to Die by *Lisa Jackson*

When Julian Rivers opens her eyes, she is trapped inside a mangled car. A stranger who claims to be a trail guide pries her free. But something about him makes her nervous. If she knew what lay ahead, she'd be a lot more than nervous. In the meantime, Detectives Selena Alvarez and Regan Pescoli are tracking down a deranged serial killer who is leaving bodies in isolated locations.

Cruel Intent by *J.A. Jance*

On a dating site, bored housewives and married men looking for sex without strings attached can find one another. But a site technician is a vengeful computer hacker looking for trouble. When the brutally murdered body of a stay-at-home mom is found, her husband is implicated. Ex-television journalist Ali Reynold's boss is accused. He swears he's innocent, and Ali is asked to investigate.

Silent Thunder by *Iris Johansen and Roy Johansen*

Hannah Bryson is a marine architect hired by the maritime museum to overhaul a Soviet era sub for exhibition. Her brother, Connor, who hired on as her assistant discovers a secret message hidden aboard ship. When Connor turns up dead after an assault on the ship, Hannah decides to pursue his killers. In her quest she discovers that the killer is using her as bait, but what could he really want?

Just After Sunset by *Steven King*

In this new collection of short stories, the author delivers a stunning collection of tales where the line between the living and the dead is blurred. Subtle, haunting, sometimes outright terrifying, it's an astonishing collection from a master storyteller.

Your Heart Belongs to Me by *Dean Koontz*

At 34, internet entrepreneur Ryan Perry seemed to have the world in his pocket until he was suddenly diagnosed with incurable heart trouble. Soon, he was on the brink of losing it all: wealth, social position and life itself. After a miraculous recovery numerous gifts in the shape of hearts begin to appear out of nowhere. And then a cryptic message from a woman who is stalking him: “your heart belongs to me!”

A Most Wanted Man by *John LeCarre*

Issa, a half starved young Russian man in a long overcoat is smuggled into Hamburg in the dead of night. Is he Muslim? And what is he doing with all that cash? Annabel, a German civil rights lawyer, is determined to save him from deportation. Her struggle leads them both to form an alliance with a 60-year old banker named Tommy Brue. Suddenly all three are being pursued by intelligence agents from three countries.

Executive Privilege by *Phillip Margolin*

Private detective Dana Cutler is hired by an attorney with political connections to follow pretty college student Charlotte Walsh. Her trail leads straight to the White House and the Office of the President. The co-ed is later found dead and Cutler is forced to flee for his life. With its non-stop action, unforgettable characters and plot that is plausibly familiar, “Executive Privilege” will get and hold your attention.

Shadow of Power by *Steve Martini*

When a controversial legal scholar, whose latest book contains shocking allegations about the U.S. Constitution and founding father Thomas Jefferson, is killed, defense attorney Paul Madriani faces his greatest challenge yet. Searching for the truth in what appears to be an open-and-shut case of murder, Madriani’s pursuit of justice pits him against the Supreme Court.

The Book of Lies by *Brad Meltzer*

In 1932, Mitchell Siegel was gunned down. His son invented the story of Superman. The murder weapon was never recovered. Fast forward to today: Cal Harper meets his long estranged father who appears to have been shot by the same weapon as Siegel. So what is the link between these two murders?

Collateral Damage by *Fern Michaels*

disaster hits, everyone discovers their need to pull together. But danger still lurks in the form of someone who wants the Dunne family to never return home.

Cross Country by *James Patterson*

In this latest Cross novel Alex Cross and Detective Briana Stone run across the worst murder case ever. As they investigate further, they uncover an underground group of thugs led by a tribal warlord known as “The Tiger”.
